Unlike many of the other great organizations that work to assist active duty personnel and Veterans, disabled or otherwise. **OPERATION PAY IT FORWARD** is self funding as up to 100% of net profits from businesses operated under the umbrella of **OPTIMAL FINANCIAL GROUP** and **OPERATION PAY IT FORWARD** are donated to projects for specific organizations such as the PA Governor's Veterans Outreach Group, Disabled American Veterans (DAV), American Legion and soon Veterans of Foreign Wars will be added to the list.

WHO'S WHO

The owner/operator of **OPERATION PAY IT FORWARD** and **OPTIMAL FINANCIAL GROUP** is Robert B. Patrick (Bob) a decorated Vietnam Veteran who served two tours of duty in the Vietnam War. The first tour was as a flight deck Doc assigned to Squadron VF-104 Phantom jets out of Alameda, California on board the aircraft carrier USS America. The second tour was in-country with the Marines, 2nd Platoon, Charlie Company, 1st Battalion, 3rd Marine Regiment, 1st Division. Hospital Corpsman Patrick was wounded on both tours with the most severe wounds occurring on his second tour in-country.



Upon returning to the States and after he was honorably discharged, went to college, had a career in hospital administration and retired in 2004 with a lot of energy and creativity that was not going to waste. So Bob launched **OPTIMAL FINANCIAL GROUP** and soon thereafter followed **OPERATION PAY IT FORWARD**

WHY DOES OPERATION PAY IT FORWARD EXIST?

First, because it is the right thing to do... Second, Hospital Corpsman Patrick's wounds left him with physical and emotional scars but it was nothing compared to what almost every Vietnam Veteran encountered upon returning home...dismay and disrespect. Bob spent over 32 years trying to find help from the Veterans' Administration. He knows there are other Veterans out there in the same situation and no one should be left to wander lost and alone after they stood up and were counted when America called upon them. So, while Bob is now in the VA system, the obligation to provide aid for Veterans today is no different than when he was there for his Marines in combat. The only difference is today Veterans are not concerned about bullets and hot shrapnel cutting into them instead many are facing the gauntlet and the maze of bureaucracy that cuts down their morale and hope of ever getting the help they need and have earned through their service to our Country.
